Windharp Horizons Themes Explained



Natural Value - This means protecting and celebrating the plants, animals, soils, and waterways that make our landscape special. It's about keeping nature healthy so future generations can enjoy it too.



Connectivity - This is about joining up patches of habitat so wildlife can move safely across the landscape. Think of it like creating nature “pathways” — linking farms, roadsides, reserves, and waterways so the whole system works together.



Resilience - Resilience means helping the land bounce back from challenges like drought, fire, pests, and climate change. Strong, diverse ecosystems cope better with change — and so do communities.



Thriving Communities - Healthy landscapes support healthy people. This principle is about community pride, wellbeing, and working together — making sure local people feel connected, involved, and supported in caring for Country.



Scientific Approach - This means using good evidence, local knowledge, and clear data to guide decisions. It's about choosing actions that genuinely help the land, not just guessing — and checking progress along the way.
